- **Extracurricular Activities and Community Service**
- **A Written Essay explaining My Accomplishments, Life Style and Interests, Leading to My Future Plans and Goals**

The application must be complete with the Name of the ICF member of Branch 380, and accompanied by the following:

- **A transcript of the applicant's scholastic record.**
- **A teacher's recommendation from whom the applicant received instruction.**
- **Letters of recommendation from 2 people, priest, employer, school official.**
- **Documented evidence of community service and extracurricular activities.**
- **An essay written in your own words describing you and your future plans.**
- **Explanation of financial need, and your contribution to your education need.**

This complete package must be received by **May 7, 2010**. All applications become the property of the ICF scholarship committee and remains confidential within the committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified and the amount of funds disclosed no later than June 5, 2010.
